



Florida Region Rankings (Revised Nov 2006)

The rankings are done by three categories. The categories are as follows:

1st Category: All National Qualifying Open Division Tournaments.

2nd Category: All National Qualifying Club Division Tournaments.

3rd Category: Regionally assigned events.

1st Category Weighting System: Open Qualifiers

Top Florida Team finishing in the 0%-25% Range would receive 18 pts.

Top Florida Team finishing in the 26%-50% Range would receive 17 pts.

Top Florida Team finishing in the 51%-75% Range would receive 14 pts.

Top Florida Team finishing in the 75%-100% Range would receive 10 pts.

If the Florida Region has several teams that are somehow in the open division, and we also have several of those teams finish well in that event then a **descending point value** would be used. This would mean the top finisher in the top 25% would receive 18 pts followed by 17 pts to the second Florida finisher and so on. If the highest Florida finisher was in the 26%-50% range the points would start descending at 16 and so on.

2nd Category Weighting System: Club Division of Qualifiers

Top Florida Team finishing in the 0%-10% Range would receive 17 pts.

Top Florida Team finishing in the 11%-25% Range would receive 16 pts.

Top Florida Team finishing in the 26%-50% Range would receive 12 pts.

Top Florida Team finishing in the 51%-75% Range would receive 8 pts.

Teams finishing in the 76%-100% Range would receive 0 pts.

If the Florida Region has several teams that are in the club division, and we have several of those teams finish well in that event then a **descending point value** would be used.

This would mean the top finisher in the top 25% would receive 16 pts followed by 15 pts to the second Florida finisher and so on. If the highest Florida finisher was in the 26%-50% range the points would start descending at 12 and so on.

3rd Category Weighting System: Regionally assigned events with 16 teams in each division.

1st place: 16pts. 2nd place: 15 pts. 3rd place: 14 pts. 5th place: 10 pts.

9th place: 8 pts. 10th place: 7 pts. 11th place: 5 pts. 13th place: 1 pt.

If the winner is not a Florida team no one is awarded the 16 pts.

Modification to the 12's and 13's ranking scale:

8-15 Teams - 12pt scale

*Note- If a team chooses to play up a division they would add a point to their finish, 2 pts if they finish in the top 4. So if a 16's team, playing in the 17's Division, finishes 5th they would get 10 pts plus 1 pt for a total of 11 pts. If the team finishes 2nd they would get 15 pts plus 2 points for a total of 17pts. If a team finishes 13-16 you receive 0 pts. If a team finishes 17th or worse they receive -1 pts.

**Note- If a Regional even has an Open and a Club division: points are awarded to the Open division first. Any remaining points fall to the club division.

Final Florida Rankings must include results from a minimum of three tournaments. If a team does not play in three events they will receive a 0 for the missing tournaments. Example: Team A plays in two events and scores a 12 and an 8 in those two events. For their final rankings you add $12 + 8 + 0 = 20 / 3 = 6.667$. The reasoning for this is to keep from having too many unranked teams to deal with at the end of the season.
